Time flies so fast. It is already March now. Leafs fall from trees. It looks different around us here in Still Water. Banana leaves are getting dry also. It is hotter and hotter every day. Most of our electrical fans are broken. We do not have air condition here. We use fans when it get real hot. We wear very thin clothes. Kids are studying hard for their final exam. We have three students that will finish six grade and will go on to seven grade. The school is far away from our house. There will be more kids coming to our Children Home. Please pray for Leah and My health. We are going to see the doctor tomorrow. I plan to go to see specialist in Ayuthaya, central Thailand. The medicine that I have taken had some side effect with my leg. Skin dry out and get rash. I was told that this is the beginning of kidney failure. I hope it will not be as bad as I was told.

Thank you very much for your support which allow us to support the children homes. There are orphans, children under poverty line, children victims of war, and children who live where there is no school. The children are improving in the education and growing in their spiritual lives. Your support is effectively alive. The House of Hope kids are in the last part of final exam. House of Hope in Theebaw and in Thachilek are busy in building the new dorm for kids. The old dorm is running down. The House of Hope in Tachilek is busy preparing the team to go out to Naga Hills for evangelism. Joseph Gwa is taking a team of 7 people to Naga Hills. Preaching and evangelizing to the animist Naga. They are also recruiting more students from the fighting area and from the most remote village in the hills. Joelee Gwa and his wife are a big help to House of Hope Myitkyina. Joseph led the kids to cut firewood for the whole new school year to come. China had invested around the flat land change the water way. Many Chinese Banana plantation have dug the canal around their plantation and change the water way which effected the irrigation around our rice paddy field. Joelee Gwa and his young wife is teaching computer and English to the House of Hope children and nearby village children as a read out program.

House of Hope of Htee Baw just finished the new dorm for the kids. They will have better room to live without rain water leaking through the roof. House of Hope is in the process of building the new dorm.

The city of Golden Triangle have put many building around our Christian community. They fill up the land and made our part lower. When the monsoon season comes all the water comes into our kids dorm. Sai Tun's father passed away a couples months ago so he would like to fillup the foundation of the house and put the kids there to stay. Most of the local people's houses are high stilt house. Because the space is limited they put room under the stilt. So now Sai Tun is trying to fill in some dirt to lift the ground up from the flood. So the kids can sleep without getting wet and be safe from scorpion and other poisonous creatures. Sai Tun and Ahdu are going to celebrate their first child Ahna's wedding on March 19. I will will be there.

More Help Needed

The evangelist in Shan State also need help. The new church being planted outside of Maing Ping township of Jiangtung division of Myanmar. On the east side Salaween river. Most of the people here are animists. They grow opium as their cash crop. As the gospel reached to them they are learning and changing. They are looking for new way of making the living that please God and help the society. There are 11 houses of believers. They finished the new bamboo building. Right now they are building the kitchen. Most of the material are available locally but they need help to get 11 pieces of 10 foot long tin roof. Which is about \$53 with the nails for tin roof their need can be \$60. Besides Lisu, there are Ahka, and Lahu tribe. The evangelist is able to reach to those people. No language problem.

More Celebrating!

Our 100 years celebration of having the Bible in our Lisu language and completed went very well. There were 1000 people came. Leah and I gave 2 pigs for feed the people who came. We also took care of the guests while they were with us. There were guests from India, Myanmar, China, and USA. They were 108 people all together. We had a great time of fellowship, worship, and celebrating. Following with that is the Lisu International Conference. This is how our brothers can come to this country to meet the rest of us who can fellowship with them.

We are in the process of building and fixing the building. The roof structured needed to be replaced. The wood has been attacked by termite. The clay wall on the adobe house needs to be recoded with better code. **Please pray that God will provide us the funds to do all the things we need not all the things that we want.**
